BJUI is inviting project proposals that will deliver education and training using new initiatives and catering for unmet needs in the delivery of urology practice. These could be designed for delivery to clinicians or patients/service users.

The charity works internationally and proposals should describe projects which reach beneficiaries on an international scale or those which have the potential to scale and be delivered elsewhere. Applications originating from any profession or location in the world are welcomed.

While any proposal that delivers education according to the BJUI's objectives will be considered, we would particularly welcome applications that are aligned to one or more of the areas below:

1. Using new learning approaches that deliver a fresh education perspective
2. Educational methods that use new technology, e.g. virtual reality or artificial intelligence
3. Proposals that increase accessibility
4. Applications that are aimed at delivering education in low/middle income countries
5. Educational methods that promote sustainability
6. Patient directed education

Funding awards of up to £20,000 for pilot studies may be awarded. BJUI reserves the right to award amounts as it feels to be commensurate with project outlined.



2. Describe why you think this proposal is innovative



4. Explain the educational outcomes and how would you demonstrate them


5. Give a summary of the benefits of the education package and what the potential barriers might be to successful delivery
